

Self-disclosure concerning RoHS (Ban of dangerous substances in electrical and electronic equipment)

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We are in close contact with our pre-suppliers in order to obtain information on restricted substances under the RoHS Directive.

Based on our current knowledge and the supplier and material information available to us, we assume that electrical and electronic equipment supplied by FATH and components intended for such equipment comply, where they fall within the scope, with Directive 2011/65/EU in its currently applicable version.

This includes the substances restricted under Annex II, including the phthalates DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP introduced by Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863, as well as the applicable exemptions under Annexes III and IV. The repealed Directive 2002/95/EC is no longer referenced as the current legal basis.

For products that are not RoHS-compliant or for which a specific exemption is applied, this information is provided in the relevant product- or order-specific documentation and confirmation.
