Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) List Update: JAN 2025

On 6 January 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued five rules concerning persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic substances under TSCA Section 6(h). The requirements are codified in 40 CFR Part 751, Subpart E. Amendments concerning decabromodiphenyl ether (decaBDE) and phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) – PIP (3:1) – were published in November 2024 and, following a postponement of the effective date, entered into force on 21 March 2025.

Based on the supplier and material information available to us, we are not aware of any uses of the below listed PBT substances in our standard products that would violate the applicable prohibitions, restrictions, exemptions, transition periods or recordkeeping requirements.

- Decabromodiphenyl Ether (decaBDE) – CASRN: 1163-19-5
- Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate (3:1) (PIP 3:1) – CASRN: 68937-41-7
- 2,4,6-tris (tert-butyl) phenol (2.4.6-TTBP) – CASRN: 732-26-3
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP) – CASRN: 133-49-3
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd) – CASRN: 87-68-3
