

Information on California Proposition 65

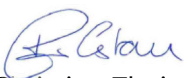
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The Proposition 65 List is continuously updated by the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment and, according to OEHHA, contains approximately 900 chemicals. Effective 17 July 2026, hydrochlorothiazide, voriconazole and tacrolimus were added to the list as chemicals known to cause cancer.

The need for a product warning cannot be determined solely on the basis of the presence of a listed chemical. The anticipated exposure must be assessed, taking into account the applicable safe harbor levels or an appropriate exposure assessment.

Based on our current knowledge and the supplier and material information available to us, FATH is not aware of exposures from its standard products that would require a warning under California Proposition 65. Customer-specific products, special applications or differing material compositions must be assessed separately.
